

Lehman Township Reorganization Meeting 2022
Agenda for 01/03/22 at 7 PM

Chairman calls the Reorganization Meeting for 2022 to order.

This meeting is recorded in order to help the recording secretary prepare the official minutes. The recording will be deleted when those minutes are approved at the next official meeting.

Chairman declares all offices vacant and appoints Ray Iwanowski as temporary Chairman and Laura Elderkin as Temporary Secretary.

Temporary Chair Raymond Iwanowski calls for Nominations for Chairman – was Dave Sutton last year.

Temporary Chairman calls for any other nominations. If only one nomination is made the Temporary Chairman declares that the office is elected and turns the meeting over to the elected Chairman.

Chairman calls for the nominations for Vice Chairman – was Ray Iwanowski last year. If only one nomination is made the Chairman declares that the office is elected.

To make all wages and salaries effective beginning January 7, 2022

To appoint Alvin Cragle as Township Treasurer.

To set the Treasurer's Bond at \$800,000.00

To appoint FNCB Bank, and Peoples Security Bank & Trust as Bank Depositories for the funds of the Township.

To appoint Laura Elderkin as Township Secretary and Recording Secretary of the Planning Commission.

To appoint Chrisandra Tosh as Administrative Assistant, Recycling Coordinator and Social Media Administrator.

To appoint Attorney Jack Haley Solicitor for the Township Supervisors and Planning Commission.

To appoint Attorney Donald Karpowich as Counsel for the Zoning Hearing Board and the UCC Board.

To appoint Douglas F. Trumbower and Associates as Township Engineer and Tim Connolly as alternate.

To appoint James Welby Zoning Officer.

To appoint Steven Egenski Primary Sewage Inspector Officer and Larry Spaciano as alternate.

To appoint James Chamberlain, Elizabeth M Chamberlain and Rachel R Simmonette as Township Auditors.

To appoint Mark Liparela as Chief of Police.

To appoint Kenneth Kluger as Police Sargent.

To appoint Harold Cain, Merrit Nash, Donald Hornlein, Justin Tokar and Edwin Weidow as full-time police officers.

To appoint Tyler Wilson, Robert Rogers and Michael Fuller Jr. as part time police officers.

To set the fee for all Officers for Magistrate and Court Hearings at \$40.00, when not on duty.

To continue the Police Uniform allowance as previously established.

To continue Vacation Policy as previously established.

To appoint Randy Howard as Vacancy Chairman to act to replace Supervisors, Auditors, Secretary and Tax Collectors of the township.

To appoint Dave Kozemchak and Dave Sutton to the planning commission for a 4-year term to expire in 2025.

To appoint John Hannish and Fred Valentine to the Zoning Hearing Board for a 5-year term to expire in 2026.

(DO NOT READ) PREPARER'S NOTE: No appointments required for UCC Board this year.

To appoint James Welby as Emergency Management coordinator.

To appoint Supervisor Ray Iwanowski as the Liaison to the Police Department and Delegate to annual Convention.

To appoint Supervisor Douglas Ide as Road master, with the power to hire and fire.

To appoint Supervisor David Sutton as Assistant Secretary and Right to Know Officer.

To purchase group Medical, Dental, Vision, Life and Disability Insurance Coverage for all Full-time employees.

To set the rate for employees and Supervisors use of Personal vehicles on Township Business at \$0.45 per mile.

To authorize Treasurer and Secretary to pay bills, bonds, Interest, Insurance Premiums, Payroll Taxes and make Transfers between accounts as needed.

To set the salary of tax collector John Oliver at \$18,000.00 per year.

To appoint Peggy Moyer and Calvin McHose agency as delinquent Tax Collectors.

To set the date, time and place of monthly meetings as advertised.

To continue Lehman Township's participation in the Back Mountain Partnership for 2022 and to appoint Ray Iwanowski as Lehman Twp. Representative and Mark Liparela as alternate.

To approve Tax Levy Resolution number 01032022.

To continue participation on the same terms in years past in the Back Mountain Regional Emergency Management Group for 2022 and to accept all elected EMA officers from all member municipalities.
